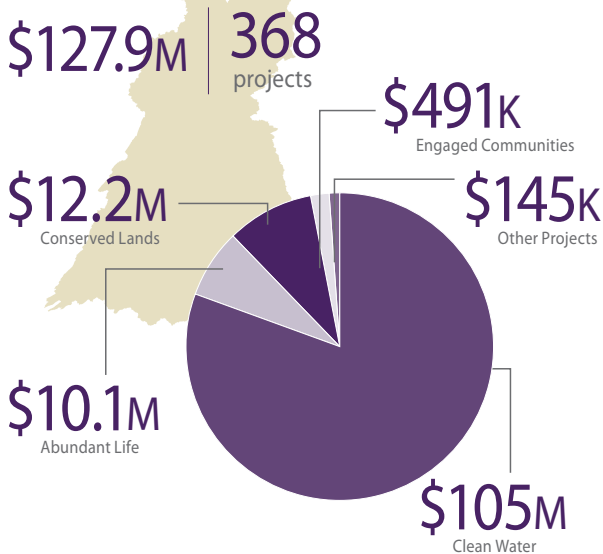


DoD Chesapeake Bay Program FY2020 Accomplishments
