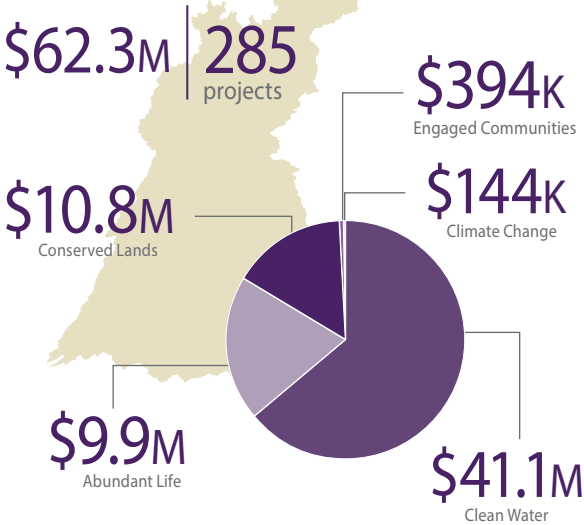


# DoD Chesapeake Bay Program FY2022 Accomplishments
