
Measurement of the total number of new, completed, and open items created on or after 01Jan 2006 in the Workplace Monitoring plans for all risk levels.

### Army Command Management System Metric 900

 Percentage of breathing zone samples with inhalation hazards that exceeded Occupational Exposure Limit (OEL), including: Time-Weighted Average (TWA); Short-Term Exposure Limit (STEL); or Ceiling Limit AND are reported in DOEHRS-IH as controlled, recommended for control, or where workers are protected.

### Army Command Management System Metric 901 & 902

- Percentage of personal noise dosimetry samples with steady-state noise exposures that are equal to or greater than a Time-Weighted Average (TWA) of 85 dBA or above AND are reported in DOEHRS-IH as controlled, recommended for control, or where workers are protected
- Percentage of dosimetry samples with impulse noise exposures > = 140 dBP

### Army Command Management System Metric 903 & 904

- Percentage of installation personnel assigned to a shop Priority Code in DOEHRS
- Percentage of DOEHRS-IH Priority 1 shops for which at least one Master Schedule task has been completed in the past 12 months
