SUBJECT: DoD Environmental Management System (EMS) Metrics for Fiscal Years
2009 through 2011

This memorandum transmits the new DoD EMS metrics to replace those previously released on September 24, 2008. The new metrics (Attachment 1) are based on Federal EMS metrics approved by the Federal Environmental Executive. DoD specific clarification guidance to the EMS metrics is provided in Attachment 2.

The EMS implementation and operation is a top priority for the federal government as evidenced by the central role it plays in Executive Order 13423 and Public Law 111-8. Your leadership in this effort is critical to improving DoD's EMS performance as measured by these metrics and the OMB Environmental Stewardship Scorecard.
