### Former Macon Naval Ordnance Plant

---

#### ***Facility and Location***

Former Macon Naval Ordnance Plant (FMNOP) Landfill site is located in an industrial part of Macon. The site was originally part of Macon Naval Ordnance Plant that included the Allied Industrial Park property immediately to the north. Macon Naval Ordnance Plant was constructed and operated by Reynolds Corporation prior to World War II. The Navy assumed operations in 1941 and continued operations until 1965 for the production of ordnance. Many of the DoD era buildings at the Allied Industrial Park are currently being used by industrial tenants.

#### ***Media Sampled and Findings***

**Groundwater** — Prior to 2007, six of seven samples detected perchlorate from 0.39 to 4.1 ppb.

#### ***Appropriate Actions***

Although all samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb, the Environmental Protection Agency is conducting a Potential Responsible Party study to determine environmental liability at the FMNOP.
