



## Kentucky Camp Breckinridge

---

### ***Facility and Location***

About 35,638 acres located in western Kentucky were selected as the location of Camp Breckinridge in 1942 for use as an infantry training site. The installation included 1,800 buildings designed to support over 250,000 troops. The facility was also used as a prisoner of war camp. The land is currently being used as farmland and for industrial, commercial, and residential development. A Historical Society museum located on the former camp documents the activities that took place at this site.

### ***Media Sampled and Findings***

**Surface Water** — Prior to 2007, three of four samples detected perchlorate from 0.02 to 0.21 ppb.

### ***Appropriate Actions***

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
