



Maryland Camp Fretterd

Facility and Location

Camp Fretterd is a 27 acre site located approximately five miles northwest of Reisterstown in Baltimore County. The facility is home to the 70th Regiment Regional Training Institute-Maryland, formerly designated as Maryland Military Academy. The unit provides instruction to leaders and recruits of the Maryland Army National Guard (ARNG). Also located on the grounds of Camp Fretterd is the Maryland State Emergency Operations Center. As of 1997, Camp Fretterd also housed the 229th Main Support Battalion, and the Counter Drug Institute. In August 1996, Camp Fretterd became the second Distributive Training Technology site in Maryland, and fifth in the United States, providing telecommuting, videoconferencing, and computer assisted distance learning, as part of the Distributive Training Technology Project. The Maryland Army National Guard acquired Camp Fretterd after the prior tenant, a reform school, was closed by the state in 1988. The Maryland ARNG thereafter upgraded the grounds and built a multi-use armory.

Media Sampled and Findings

Drinking Water — In 2011, two of two samples detected perchlorate at 0.05 and 0.37 ppb.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
