



## Maine NAS Brunswick

---

### ***Facility and Location***

Naval Air Station (NAS) Brunswick closed in September 2011 as a result of 2005 Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) requirements. Potable water was supplied to NAS Brunswick through a municipal water system. There were two additional well systems that supplied potable water in the past which are no longer used.

### ***Media Sampled and Findings***

**Drinking Water** — In 2008, one sample reported no detection. In 2007, two samples reported no detection. Prior to 2007, two samples reported no detection.

**Groundwater** — In 2010, five of five samples detected perchlorate from 0.07 to 0.17 ppb.

### ***Appropriate Actions***

Under the Military Munitions Response Program, the Navy conducted one round of groundwater sampling for perchlorate at five well locations at the former Machine Gun Boresight Range in 2010. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb. There are two former munitions areas which will be sampled in 2012.
