



## Michigan Selfridge ANGB

### ***Facility and Location***

Selfridge Air National Guard Base (ANGB) occupies approximately 3,082 acres in Macomb County approximately two miles east of Mount Clemens and 25 miles north of downtown Detroit.

The explosive ordnance disposal (EOD) range was established in July 1969 while Selfridge ANGB was still an active duty base. The range was established to provide a training area for EOD personnel assigned to the base. Range operations have always been under the control of the EOD unit assigned to the base. In 1971, the Michigan Air National Guard gained control of the EOD range, and the 75th Ordnance Company controlled the range until it was inactivated in 1991 and permanently closed in March 2004. Between 1991 and 2004, the range was used for emergency destruction. It is located in a remote part of Selfridge ANGB and the area has been unused, for the most part, since the range was closed.

### ***Media Sampled and Findings***

**Groundwater** — In 2008, one of five samples detected perchlorate at 1.2 ppb.

### ***Appropriate Actions***

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
