Facility and Location

Naval Air Station (NAS) Meridian hosts Training Wing One and training squadrons VT-7 and VT-9. All training squadrons operate the T-45 (Goshawk). The main base of NAS Meridian occupies more than 8,000 acres with an additional 4,000 acres at Joe Williams Field and the target facility SEARAY. Approximately 3,442 military, civilians, and dependents work or live at the air station.

NAS Meridian supports aviation and technical training and other tenant activities. The Administrative Services Department provides general administrative services for the command. Responsibilities include processing military personnel matters with the Personnel Support Activity Detachment, Meridian; processing special requests, leave, Tactical Air Defense orders, evaluations, and command correspondence; maintaining command directives and correspondence files; providing duplicating services and messenger systems; and coordinating administrative systems and services throughout the command.
