



North Carolina Corolla Naval Target

Facility and Location

In 1944, the Navy began leasing 182 acres from the Monkey Island Club and used the target as a combination bombing, strafing, and rocket target until 1965, at which time all leases were canceled. Currently, the 182 acres is part of the Currituck National Wildlife Refuge and additional acreage from the range fan is a combination of wildlife refuge, residential land, and open ocean.

Media Sampled and Findings

Drinking Water — In 2007, three of four samples detected perchlorate from 0.25 to 0.32 ppb.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
