Facility and Location

The New Hampshire National Guard Training Site is 104 acres, 20 of which are cantonment area and the remainder being semi or unimproved training lands. The site currently houses the 195th Training Regiment and Recruit sustainment program. The site is used for land navigation, officer candidate school, driver training on combat trails system, and a Mobile Operations on Urban Terrain (MOUT) site. Limited pyrotechnics are used.

Media Sampled and Findings

Drinking Water — In 2011, two samples reported no detection.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
