



## New York Fort Drum

---

### ***Facility and Location***

Fort Drum, previously known as Camp Pine and Camp Drum, is located in the North Country, Thousand Islands Region of New York on 107,625 acres. The fort is approximately 30 miles from Canada, with the Great Lakes to the west and the Adirondack Mountains to the east. The mission includes command of active component units assigned to the installation, administrative and logistical support to tenant units, support to active and reserve units from all services in training at Fort Drum, and planning and support for the mobilization and training of almost 80,000 troops annually. This includes the New York Army National Guard. The host unit is the 10th Mountain Division (Light Infantry).

### ***Media Sampled and Findings***

**Drinking Water** — In 2009, 7 of 14 samples detected perchlorate from 0.15 to 0.74 ppb. Prior to 2007, two samples reported no detection.

**Groundwater** — In 2009, two of nine samples detected perchlorate from 0.12 to 0.91 ppb.

**Surface Water** — In 2010, 15 samples reported no detection. In 2009, 16 samples reported no detection.

### ***Appropriate Actions***

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
