



South Dakota Sioux City Precision Bombing Range No. 2

Facility and Location

Sioux City Precision Bombing Range (PBR) No. 2 is located approximately six miles west of Elk Point in Union County. The PBR was commissioned in 1942 and used primarily as an air-to-ground gunnery and bombing practice facility. The range was comprised of one 3,000 foot diameter circle bombing target, while the entire property was used for air-to-ground gunnery practice. The PBR was decommissioned on December 12, 1945 and the leases terminated in April and May of 1946.

Media Sampled and Findings

Drinking Water — In 2007, one of two samples detected perchlorate at 0.25 ppb.

Groundwater — In 2007, one sample reported no detection.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
