Facility and Location

The 149th Fighter Wing was formed on July 1, 1960 but originated from the 396th Fighter Squadron which was activated in June 1943 and served during WW II. The 396th, after numerous decorations for service, was re-designated the 182nd Fighter Squadron as part of the 136th Fighter Wing. They were the first Air National Guard Unit to see combat during the Korean War. Despite several reorganizations during its history, the 149th has always flown fighter aircraft including the F-16 C/D which is presently still in use. The 149th is currently a training wing.

Media Sampled and Findings

Drinking Water — Prior to 2007, two samples reported no detection.

Appropriate Actions
