Air Force Plant 4

Facility and Location

Air Force Plant (AFP) 4 is a government-owned contractor-operated (GOCO) defense manufacturing facility north of Fort Worth. The plant has manufactured military bombers and fighter aircraft since 1942 and is currently operated by Lockheed Martin Corporation. As of the end of the Cold War, the plant was fabricating, assembling, and testing the F-16 fighter for the Air Force and ten allied nations. In March 1992, Lockheed Martin took over the operation of the plant to produce F-16, F-35, and F-22 aircraft components. Additionally, the plant produces spare aircraft parts, radar units, and missile components.

Media Sampled and Findings

Groundwater — Prior to 2007, four samples from OT22, reported no detection.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
