



## Texas Camp Bowie

### ***Facility and Location***

Camp Bowie is a National Guard site located in west of Fort Worth in west central Texas. On August 1, 1946 the War Department notified Texas members of Congress that the Camp had been declared surplus. The Civilian War Assets Administration was to take charge and began the distribution of the land and buildings. Camp Bowie suffered a large grass fire in July of 2008, where several hundred acres of dry grassy areas of the facility were burned. Camp Bowie remains an active military training station and recently completed construction of new facilities including a firing range and several ammunition storage bunkers. Camp Bowie provides training support for the Texas Army National Guard including vehicle maintenance and repair.

### ***Media Sampled and Findings***

**Drinking Water** — In 2011, two of two samples detected perchlorate at 0.03 and 0.04 ppb.

### ***Appropriate Actions***

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
