Red River Arsenal Rifle Range

Facility and Location

Red River Arsenal Rifle Range is located near the city of Texarkana, which lies between Bowie County, Texas and Miller County, Arkansas. In addition to the rifle range, the site included a machine gun range, two anti-aircraft ranges, an infiltration course, a street fighting course, and a booby trap installation. Historical documentation indicates the 118 acre site, along with the 6,460 acres of leased land (impact and safety areas), was first acquired in 1943. The leased acreage was declared surplus by 1948 and disposal of the 118 acres was completed in 1958.

Media Sampled and Findings

Groundwater — In 2007, two of two samples detected perchlorate at 0.17 and 0.18 ppb.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
