NAS Oceana Dam Neck Annex

Facility and Location

Naval Air Station (NAS) Oceana Dam Neck is located on the Atlantic Coast, five miles south of Virginia Beach. Dam Neck covers over 1,100 acres of highlands, marshes, coastal beaches, and sand dunes. Dam Neck was established in 1941 as a gunnery range to train personnel in the operation of 20 and 40 millimeter anti-aircraft guns. Today, Dam Neck Annex and its tenant commands are primarily focused on Navy Fleet training and support activities.

Media Sampled and Findings

Drinking Water — In 2007, one sample detected perchlorate at 0.12 ppb. Prior to 2007, one sample detected perchlorate at 0.11 ppb.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
