Naval Radio Station Transmitter Jim Creek

Facility and Location

In the foothills of the North Cascade Mountains just outside of Arlington is the Naval Radio Station Transmitter Jim Creek Recreation Area. Spruce covered mountains, located on 5,000 largely forested acres, provide radio transmitting capabilities for the Pacific submarine fleet. Jim Creek has managed, handled, and utilized only small arms ammunition.

Media Sampled and Findings

Appropriate Actions
