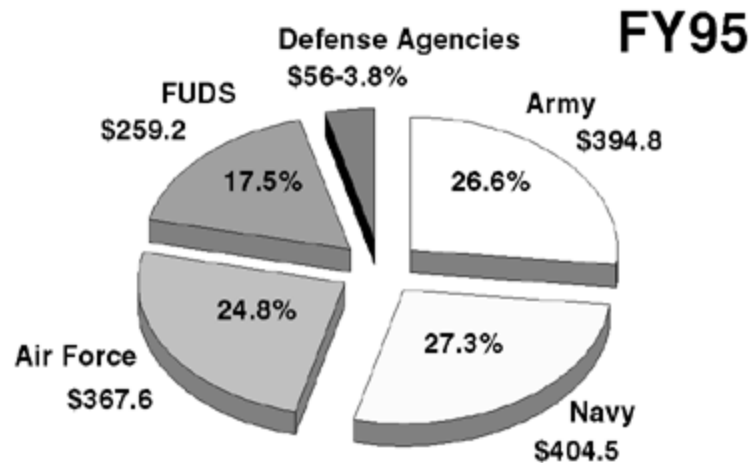


DoD Component Status and Progress

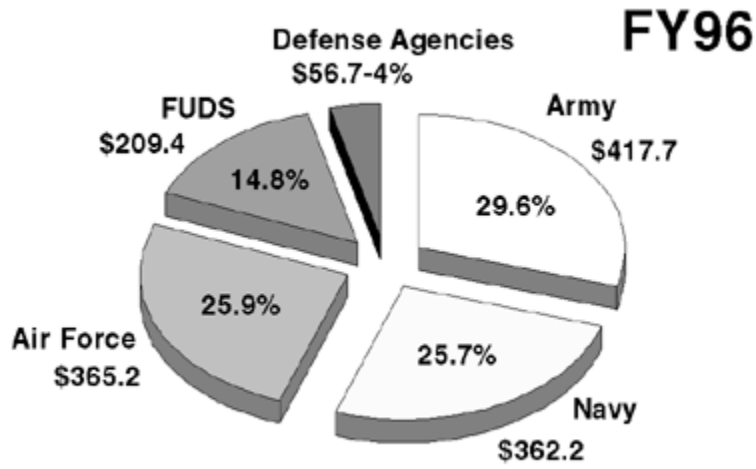

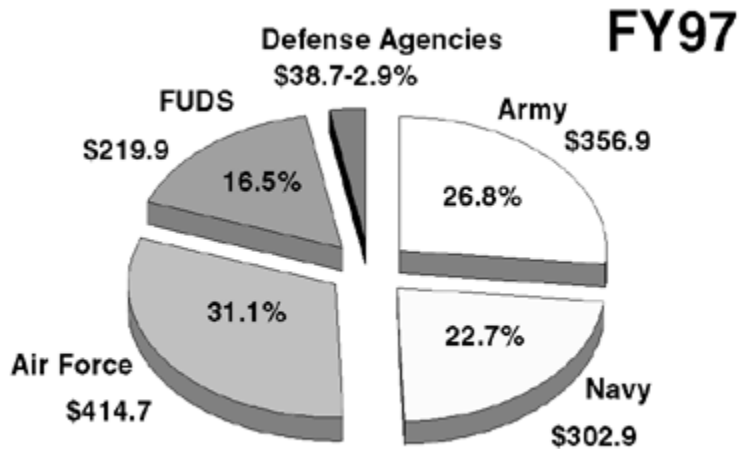
DERA Funding Profile for Military Departments, Defense Agencies, and FUDS



Total \$1,412.6 Million



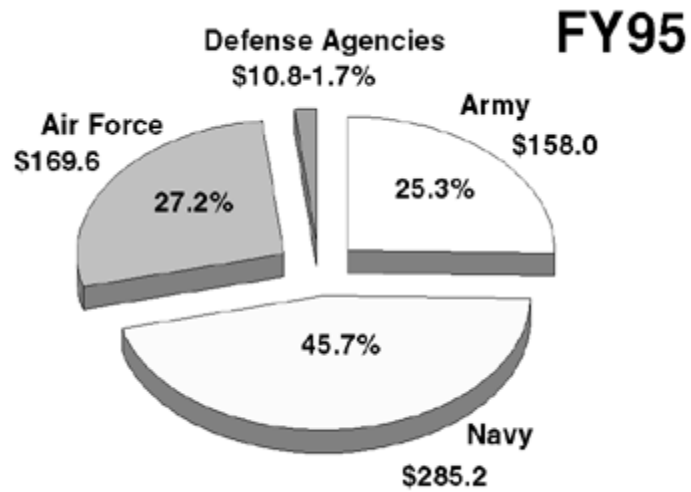

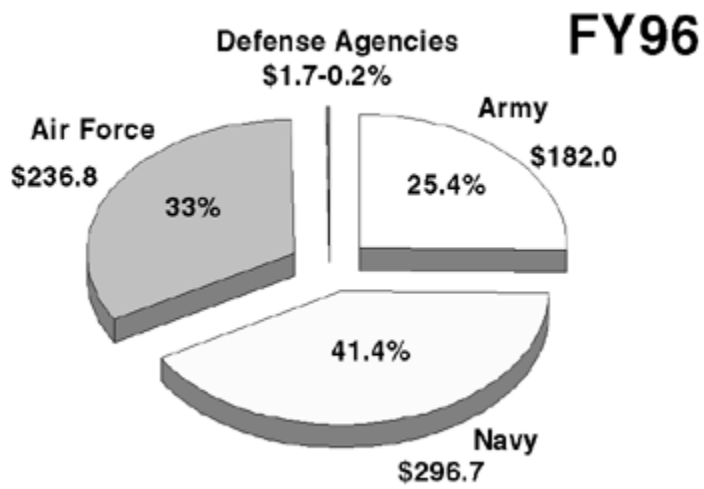

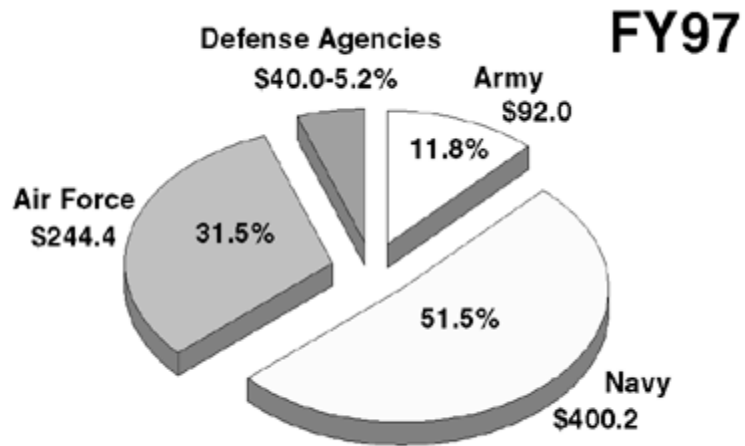
BRAC Environmental Funding Profile for Military Departments and Defense Agencies
