APPENDIX I FY 2002 PROJECTS GREATER THAN \$1.5 MILLION

Working with Congressional staff, DoD developed and submitted a legislative proposal in FY 1998 to both improve and streamline the information included in the Environmental Quality Annual Report to Congress. In section 322 of the FY 2000 Defense Authorization Act, Congress amended the statutory language in section 2706 of title 10, United States Code as follows—

- "(b) Report on Environmental Quality Programs and Other Environmental Activities
 - (2) Each report shall include the following:
- ... (D) A list of the planned or ongoing projects necessary to support the environmental quality programs during the period covered by the report, the cost of which has exceeded or is anticipated to exceed \$1,500,000."

This appendix lists all projects valued at \$1.5 million or greater that—

- Were identified to Congress as part of the FY 2001 budget request
- Are now included in the FY 2001 program due to emergent circumstances
- Are included in the FY 2002 budget request.

Reports track each project of \$1.5 million or greater for inclusion in the budget request, through the appropriations process and project execution. The data from fiscal years prior to FY 2000 are not available because the requirement to track execution was not in place prior to the enactment of the revised reporting requirement.

<u>Please note</u>: The FY 2000 MILCON budget request reflected an advanced appropriations funding policy, based on historical appropriation outlay rates. Subsequently, Congress denied use of this financing technique and fully funded all of the FY 2000 projects. The cost increase between the FY 2000 President's Budget Request and the FY 2000 Allocated as of Sept. 30, 2000 amount reflects this Congressional Action. Projects that were affected by this are marked with an (*) in the tables that follow.
