

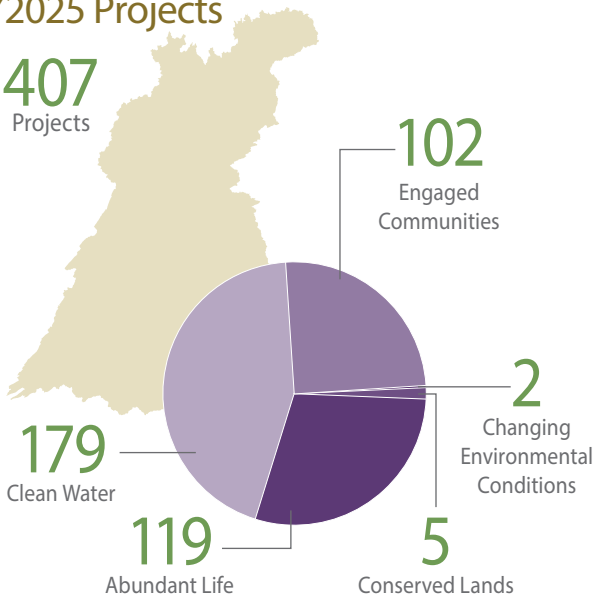
DoW Chesapeake Bay Program FY2025 Accomplishments

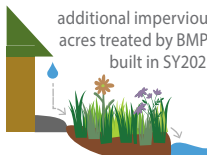

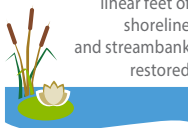
