 - Camp CCs aggressively resolved concerns

- Examples of deployed environmental and occ health issues are not unique to a particular service
- Technical Issues
 - No Problems
 - + AF & Army have different skill sets within each specialty
 - My Recommendations:
 - Entomologist & PHO at northern sites
 - BEE & PHO at southern sites
 - No Pest Mgmt Tech if services contracted out
 - Contract Vehicles for PMTAF
- Admin/Organization
 - + AF had to adapt to Army terminology and structure
