This brown-headed cowbird trap is part of a project to help the endangered Kirtland's warbler. This warbler nests only in Michigan and *nowhere else in the world!* Cowbirds damage Kirtland's warbler nests. Cowbirds caught in this trap are removed and all other birds captured here are released unharmed.
