MIGRATION AND WINTERING RECORDS OF KIRTLAND'S WARBLER:

AN ANNOTATED BIBLIOGRAPHY

Kirtland's Warbler (<u>Dendroica kirtlandii</u>) was first collected sometime during Samuel Cabot's expedition in the fall of 1840 or 1841 at sea between Cuba and Abaco Island, Bahamas. It was not until 13 May 1851, when Charles Pease collected the type specimen, an immature male, near Cleveland, Ohio, that the new bird was identified. Pease gave the specimen to his father-in-law, Dr. Jared P. Kirtland, who in turn sent it to Spencer F. Baird. Baird described the bird and named it for Kirtland, a well-known naturalist of the time (Baird 1864-1872, Griscom and Sprunt 1979).

Based on these and the subsequent few observations, it was believed Kirtland's Warbler wintered in Cuba and returned to the eastern United States to breed, though North American records were concentrated in Ohio (Ulrey 1893). Subsequent winter records defined a range confined to the Bahamas. To date, the relatively few wintering records, save one (Faanes 1985) all come from the Bahamas. No nests were found until 8 July 1903 when Norman A. Wood discovered a breeding colony in Crawford County, Michigan (Wood 1904). Further observations revealed this rare warbler breeds only in jack pines (<u>Pinus banksiana</u>) in a 6-county region in Michigan (Iosco, Crawford, Kalkaska, Ogemaw, Oscoda and Roscommon counties encompass the current known distribution) (Payne 1983). There have been records of males defending territories outside this area, but no evidence of breeding has been found in any other location (Harrington 1939, Tilghman 1979).

The decline of Kirtland's Warbler numbers is well-documented but not well-understood. Recent speculation has considered the possibility of losses of wintering habitat (Keast and Morton 1980) and mortality due to inclement weather conditions encountered during migration (Trautman 1979, Ryel 1981).

In order to evaluate these hypotheses, it is necessary to examine the chronological and geographical distribution of migration and wintering records, and this was the inspiring force behind this bibliography. However, it may also serve as a useful reference for persons interested in avian migration, endangered species, Bahama birds, or ornithological history.

Many of the references noted here are also included in Huber's (1982) comprehensive compilation. This bibliography could not have been completed without referring to that work, and some elements of its format have been incorporated here for the purpose of clarity and consistency. This bibliography contains pre-1980 references not included in Huber (1982) and post-1980 references up to and including 1986. In addition, museum records¹ and unpublished field records have been listed and cross-references with published accounts where possible. Citations are cross-referenced with museum records and other citations describing the same information. Each citation has been assigned a code indicating its reliability. Discrepancies, in the published literature often occur between two or more accounts; therefore, only the information given in the text of the citation in question was used in assigning reliability codes, and two similar citations may bear different codes. These are as follows:

(S)--a specimen of Kirtland's Warbler was collected and positively identified

¹Museums likely to contain study skins collected during migration or wintering, based on the published literature, were contacted. This provided a fairly complete coverage; however, some specimens in other collections may have been missed.

(D)--a detailed description is included in the account OR the bird was seen by someone familiar with it OR the record was accepted by an ornithological review committee

(M)--the bird was mist-netted and banded AND/OR photographed

(P)--the bird was possibly a Kirtland's Warbler, but there is some

reasonable doubt

- (?)--unable to evaluate this record due to lack of information
- []--numbers in brackets indicate the page on which Kirtland's warbler information is actually found.

Where possible, the number of birds, maturity of the bird(s), sex(es), precise date and location and general habit (except Michigan habitats) of each record has been noted. In the absence of this information, the record is transcribed as it appears in the original publication. If no numerical qualification is given, as in "? 12 Oct. 1941", one bird may be inferred.






