Bird Checklist for Fort Wainwright, Alaska: Yukon Training Area



The Yukon Training Area occupies 257,281 acres of the Middle Tanana Valley. The Yukon Training Area (YTA) lies within the Yukon-Tanana Uplands, which consists of rounded, even-topped ridges with gentle side slopes, broad divides, flat-topped spurs, and gently sloping plains. Ridges occupy nearly 10% of the area, oriented in a northeast-southwest direction. Elevations range from 192 to 3,285 feet. The YTA is comprised of a variety of habitats, such as forests of white spruce, paper birch, and quaking aspen; black spruce bogs; thickets of willow and alder; meadows, and Alpine Scrub. These habitats are important to a variety of songbirds, shorebirds, and upland game birds. Some of the more significant species known to utilize the area are: ruffed grouse, red-tailed hawks, northern harriers, American kestrels, great horned owls, northern hawk owls, boreal owls, goldeneyes and numerous small passerine species including warblers, thrushes, flycatchers, and sparrows.
