Subj: PROFICIENCY TESTING FOR ANALYTES IN ISOMER GROUPS

- 1. This memo is to provide clarification on the appropriate proficiency test (PT) analytes needed for accreditation of analytes within isomer groups.
- 2. To provide assurance of the accuracy of each analyte, the listing of the analytes on the scope must match that of the PT. For example, if the laboratory lists m,p-xylene and o-xylene separately on the scope, the analytes must be reported separately on the PT. If the laboratory only lists total xylene on their scope, they may report only total xylene for the PT. The laboratory may also list all of the analytes (i.e., m,p-xylene, o-xylene, and total xylenes) on the scope and must report all analytes on the PT. The same PT may be used for all the analytes. The same would apply for other isomer groups.
