

# Evolution of EM CX

- 1982 - Superfund Design Center
- 1984 - FUDS Mission
- 1986 - IRP Mission
- 1990 - Ordnance and Explosives (OE) CX established
- 1991 - Radioactive/Mixed Waste CX
- 1992 - HTRW-CX established
- 1993 - Civil Works Compliance mission
- 2004 - OE CX renamed the Military Munitions (MM) CX
- 2007 - Environmental and Munitions CX merged and established
- 2011 - EM CX Revalidated

\* We do not execute work at a project level; our primary mission is to technically support the districts executing projects!


