


HUMAN WEAPON SYSTEM F100 Engine Performance Threats

HOW WE PROTECT OURSELVES

- Medical Intelligence
 - ID threats, assess risk, determine countermeasures
- Warrior Health Assessment
 - · current PHA & dental exam, health questionnaire
- Immunizations & Screenings
 - shots & malaria pills, HIV/serum bank, TB test
- Personal Protection
 - repellent, bed nets, hearing & respiratory protection
- Education and Documentation are Key



WHAT WE DO FHP During Deployment

- Site Selection & Set-up
 - partner with CE to avert potential health problems
 - partner with LGC & SV for safe food, water, billeting
- Surveillance
 - DNBI data collection, analysis, & reporting
 - food & water safety/vulnerability
 - environmental & occupational hazards/risks
- DNBI Prevention, Investigation & Remediation
 - anticipate, recognize, evaluate & control problems
- Education and Documentation are Key



WHAT WE DO Re/Post-Deployment FHP

- Health Assessment
 - health questionnaire
 - medical follow-up as required
- Prophylaxis & Screenings
 - malaria pills, HIV/serum bank & TB test as required
- Medical Debrief
 - all significant health events & exposures
- · After Action Reporting
- Education and Documentation are Key
