A DoD American Indian Cultural Communications and Consultation Course (AICCCC) for Action Officers is scheduled for April 19-21, 2023, at Naval Air Station Fallon in Fallon, Nevada. The course will be conducted from 0900-1700 the first two days and 0900-1200 on the final day. American Indian specialists in local history, culture, intercultural communication, consultation, and legal experts will teach this acclaimed training.

This **free** introductory course provides valuable information for uniformed and civilian DoD employees whose work may have an effect on Indian tribes. The training will include:

- History of Indian-related laws and the legal basis for DoD Policies
- History and Culture of Tribes affiliated with installation lands
- Federal laws and policies that impact relationships with Indian tribes
- DoD's Instruction 4710.02: DoD Interactions with Federally Recognized Tribes
- An update on Administration priorities concerning Native Americans
- Intercultural communication best practices
- Strategies and practical steps for consulting with tribes
