



California MCAS Pendleton

Facility and Location

Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Pendleton is a full service air station capable of handling both rotary and fixed wing aircraft located on 488 acres of land approximately seven miles from the main gate at Marine Corps Base. It was established on September 25, 1942 in order to support Marine aviation in World War II. MCAS Pendleton is located adjacent to the Santa Margarita River and is currently home to the tenant squadrons of Marine Air Group 39 and Marine Air Group Logistics Squadron 39.

Media Sampled and Findings

Groundwater — In 2008, one sample reported no detection. Prior to 2007, three samples reported no detection.

Appropriate Action

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
