Shelbyville Army Aviation Support Facility

Facility and Location

The Shelbyville Army Aviation Support Facility (AASF) is located in Shelby County approximately four miles northwest of the City of Shelbyville. The facility is surrounded by agricultural property to the south and west, the Shelbyville Municipal Airport and a self-storage facility to the east, and light industrial/warehouse facilities to the north. The AASF was constructed in 1971 and is supported by approximately 75 to 100 military personnel. It includes an aircraft hangar, ground power shop, flight line, fuel farm, motor pool, onsite package wastewater treatment plant, administrative offices, chemical storage sheds, and parking areas.

Media Sampled and Findings

Drinking Water — In 2011, two samples reported no detection.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were confirmed to be below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
