Fort George G. Meade

Facility and Location

Located midway between Baltimore and Washington, D.C., Fort George G. Meade was established as an Army installation in 1917. Fort Meade became a training center during World War II; its ranges and other facilities were used by the Army to train approximately 3,500,000 men between 1942 and 1946. Fort Meade's current mission is to act as an administrative installation supporting the missions of over 114 tenants representing a wide variety of training, intelligence, and educational programs.

Media Sampled and Findings

Drinking Water — Prior to 2007, four samples reported no detection.

Appropriate Actions
