



New Jersey Atlantic City Naval Air Station

Facility and Location

Atlantic City Naval Air Station land was leased by the Navy in 1942 and was active until 1958, at which time it was declared excess. Some improvements to the site consisted of storage magazines, work huts, a pistol/machine gun range, skeet ranges, and a shooting-in-butt range. The property was transferred to the Federal Aviation Administration for use in 1958, but a small portion of the property was retained by the state of New Jersey for use as the Atlantic City International Airport and another portion was leased to the New Jersey National Guard.

Media Sampled and Findings

Surface Water — In 2007, three of three samples detected perchlorate from 0.03 to 0.07 ppb.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
