



## Texas Dyess AFB

### ***Facility and Location***

Dyess Air Force Base (AFB), originally Abilene Army Air Field, is a 6,342 acre base located in the southwest corner of Abilene. The base hosts the 7th Bomb Wing, Air Combat Command, which operates B-1B bombers and the only B-1B combat crew training squadron. The 7th Bomb Wing's mission is to provide bombing training and combat support for combatant commanders worldwide.

### ***Media Sampled and Findings***

**Drinking Water** — In 2007, one sample reported no detection. Prior to 2007, one of two samples detected perchlorate at 0.1 ppb.

### ***Appropriate Actions***

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
