Facility and Location

Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base (NAS JRB) Fort Worth, also known as Carswell Field, is a military airfield located five miles west of the central business district of Fort Worth in Tarrant County. The Air Force Reserve Command's Tenth Air Force headquarters, 301st Fighter Wing, and 136th Airlift Wing of the Texas Air National Guard are based here. A number of Marine Corps aviation and ground units are also located at NAS JRB Fort Worth.

Aircraft types initially based at NAS JRB Fort Worth were the F-14 Tomcat and McDonnell Douglas C-9B Skytrain II. Current aircraft include the F/A-8 Hornet and C-40 Clipper (Navy), F-16 Fighting Falcon and C-130 Hercules (Air Force), and F/A-18 Hornet and KC-130 Hercules (Marine Corps).

Media Sampled and Findings

Drinking Water — In 2007, one sample reported no detection. Prior to 2007, one sample detected perchlorate at 1 ppb.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
