



Washington NAVHOSP Bremerton

Facility and Location

Naval Hospital (NAVHOSP) Bremerton, located on the site of the Former Naval Ammunition Depot (NAD) Puget Sound, was established in 1904. Until the development of NAVHOSP Bremerton in 1980, all properties of NAD Puget Sound were constantly being developed or renovated to accommodate mission operations of moving, storing, assembling, cleaning, and demilitarization of military weapons, ammunition, and magazines. NAVHOSP Bremerton is a parent command to three branch medical clinics located in outlying areas and the 500 bed transportable Fleet Hospital Bremerton. Currently, there are no weapons used or maintained at the NAVHOSP beyond small arms utilized by the security staff.

Media Sampled and Findings

Drinking Water— In 2007, two samples reported no detection.

Surface Water — In 2009, one sample reported no detection.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
