



Kirtland Air Force Base

Located near Albuquerque, NM, Kirtland is one of the largest installations (52,600 acres) in Air Force Materiel Command and is home to the Command's Nuclear Weapons Center and its subordinate wings - the 498th Armament Systems Wing and the 377th Air Base Wing. It is also home to the Defense Threat Reduction Agency Albuquerque office, the Air Force Safety Center, the Air Force Inspection Agency, the Air Force Operational Test and Evaluation Center, the 58th Special Operations Wing, Space Development and Test Wing, the New Mexico Air National Guard 150th Fighter Wing, the Directed Energy and Space Vehicle Directorates of the Air Force Research Laboratory, the Department of Energy Albuquerque Office, the National Nuclear Security Administration, and Sandia National Laboratories.



White Sands Missile Range (WSMR)

White Sands Missile Range (WSMR) is a tri-service range, supporting development, operational testing and evaluation for the Army, Air Force, Navy, allied foreign governments, universities, commercial, and private entities. WSMR provides unique infrastructure and test facilities, capped off with a modernized range control center. WSMR is the Department of the Army's (DA) largest installation, covering nearly 2.2 million acres. It is bordered by Fort Bliss (TX) to the south and by Holloman Air Force Base to the east. WSMR is a main employer of personnel from the Las Cruces and El Paso areas, as well as the surrounding communities.



Holloman Air Force Base

Holloman Air Force Base is home to the 49th Wing supporting national security objectives by deploying worldwide to support peacetime and wartime contingencies. The 49th provides combat-ready Airmen, pilots and sensor operators for F-22 Raptors, MQ-1 Predators and MQ-9 Reapers. Additionally, the wing delivers Air Transportable Clinics and Basic Expeditionary Airfield Resources while providing support to more than 17.000 military and civilian personnel to include German Air Force Flying Training center operations.

Doña Ana Range

The 295,538 acre Doña Ana Complex includes state-of-the-art live weapons firing ranges and on and off road maneuver training areas. Aerial drop zones and artillery firing areas are located in the western part of the Training Areas. Two Range Camps provide mission support facilities.





Fort Bliss & McGregor Range McGregor range includes approximately 695,354 acres and provides many varied training experiences including tank trails, on and off road maneuver areas, live firing ranges from pistol to missile, including the most advanced Digital Air Ground Integration Range in the Army, multiple cutting-edge training villages, an Air Force Bombing Range, and a large Base Camp.



New Mexico National Guard and other Reserve Components

The Guard and Reserve organize, train, and equip citizen soldiers/airmen to ensure their rapid mobilization for duties within the state, nation and around the world. While all Reserve Components have a federal mission to augment active duty forces in times of crises, the Guard has the additional, unique mission of serving the Governor during state emergencies. Guard and Reserve units are stationed throughout the state.



Cannon Air Force Base

Cannon Air Force Base is home to the 27th Special Operations Wing. The primary mission of the 27th Special Operations Wing is to plan and execute specialized and contingency operations using advanced aircraft, tactics, and air refueling techniques to infiltrate, exfiltrate, and resupply special operations forces, and provide intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance, and close air support.
