

AMNESTY PROGRAM

An amnesty program is a “no-questions-asked” initiative that allows Soldiers and Civilians to return unauthorized, leftover, or abandoned ammunition without fear of disciplinary action, investigation, or prosecution. Its primary goal is to get hazardous materials back into proper military control safely and quickly.

If you or your family have souvenir munitions, call local law enforcement to report it. Turn them in safely by following the 3Rs of Explosives Safety:

-  **R**ecognize – the danger that a souvenir munition poses to you, your family, and your neighbors.
-  **R**etreat – do not touch, move or disturb it. Do not give or throw it away.
-  **R**eport – call law enforcement and tell the operator you have a souvenir munition.
